

GED PREPARATION

Students 18 years of age or older can enroll for classes during the dates listed below. The class registration fee is \$20. If you are under 18 years of age, please contact Kristina for a minor waiver form and more information. Payments can be made with Visa, Mastercard, cash, or check. The \$20 registration fee will be reimbursed after successfully passing the post-assessment test.

For FREE GED Testing, students must attend 40 hours of class, pass the GED Practice Test, and follow the attendance policy. The State of Michigan is providing free testing for those who meet those requirements based on the GED-to-School program. The GED Test cost for anyone who does not register for classes is \$150.

Space is limited so register during the dates listed below to assure you are registered for the class. Bus tokens are available. Career assessment and employability preparation will be given as part of our comprehensive program.

Good attendance is important and mandatory as preparation is vital to your success in passing the GED test. You must follow our attendance policy to remain in this program. This self-paced program ends May 13, 2019.

Step #1: Registration (Choose a day below)

\$20 for non-refundable registration fee, State ID or birth certificate, and your high school transcripts. You will also need to know your social security number.

Step #2: Pre-Assessment Test

Times will vary. You will sign up for your time at registration.

Step #3: First Day Of Class

Monday, September 17

Classes will meet on Mondays and Wednesdays. Class is from 3:30-6:30 p.m., a total of 6 hours per week until you take the GED test.

How do I register and pay

Am I eligible to take the GED?

- 18 years of age or older and did not receive a high school diploma
- 16 years of age and State has approved the waiver form



How much does the GED Test cost in Michigan?

- Pay for one subject at a time
- Each subject costs \$37.50
- Retake tests (within year)
\$10.00

The GED test has four subjects:

Social Studies
Language Arts
Science
Math



How long will it take?

- Math - 115 minutes
- Science - 90 minutes
- Social Studies - 90 minutes
- Reasoning through Language
• Arts - 150 minutes

What types of questions are on the test?

- Multiple choice
- Drag and drop
- Hot spot (select an area)
 - Fill in the blank
 - Short answer
- Extended response
