


GED TESTING

- **How do I register and pay for the GED?** www.ged.com
- **Am I eligible to take the GED test?**
Must be 18 years of age or older and did not receive a high school diploma or 16 years of age and State has approved waiver form
- **How much does the GED test cost in Michigan?** Pay for one subject at a time at \$37.50 each, retake tests within one year are \$10, free to class participants
- **The GED Test has Four Subjects**
Social Studies, Science, Math and Language Arts
- **How long will it take?** Reasoning through Language Arts-155 min
Science-95 minutes
Social Studies-75 minutes
Math-120 minutes
- **What types of questions are on the test?** Multiple choice, drag and drop, hot spot (fill in), short answer and extended response

GED PREPARATION

- Must be 18 years of age or older or contact Coordinator to apply for a minor waiver
- Class Registration Fee \$20, payable by Visa, MasterCard, cash or check
- \$20 Registration Fee reimbursed to student after successfully passing post-assessment
- FREE GED testing after 40 hours of class & passing GED practice test
- \$25 reward for passing first GED test
- Small student to teacher ratio
- Classes meet Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:30 –6:30 p.m. at the Tuscola Technology Center
- Total of 6 hours per week until you complete your GED tests
- Test costs \$150 for anyone not registered in class
